What is a Learning Review?

- A means of bringing relevant agencies together through a structure process to review what has taken place to
 - Reflect
 - Increase understanding
 - Identify effective practice
 - Identify key learning
- A collective endeavour to learn from what has taken place in order to improve systems and practice in future and better protect those most vulnerable who we support.
- This is not a Significant Case Review!
