7 Minute Briefing

What is it?

This is a NEW pathway – developed by NHS Grampian, Primary Care and Social Work colleagues.

It is designed to support a clear, agreed, way for professionals to access and provide assessments of capacity when there are risks and concerns for the individual in question.

It works alongside, but is distinct from, the current Decisions Specific Capacity Screening Tool.

2 Why have a Pathway?
Both learning reviews and multiagency inspections in Grampian have identified a need for clear arrangements to access assessments of capacity when individuals are at risk of harm.

The decision to develop a dedicated capacity pathway was led by NHS Grampian, but supported by Primary Care and Social Work colleagues.

Will it be reviewed?

Yes! As this is the first time a Capacity Pathway has been put in place across Grampian, it will be reviewed in 12 months time.

The original working group will continue to monitor the rollout and first year of the pathway.
