- Consistent Approach
- Specific Hoarding risk assessment
- Multi-Agency Process Map
- Tie in with Non-ASP Adult Case Conference Process

# Hoarding Intervention Training

- Linda Fay, Hoarding Academy.
- Measuring effectiveness of training
- Post-training questionnaire
- Increased staff confidence to have the tools and knowledge to work with these types of cases
- Culture of Improvement in Hoarding related cases

# Hoarding Surgery

- Specific Practitioner Forum for hoarding related cases
- Quarterly basis
- Multi-Agency buy-in
- Speakers, networking, Practice discussion

- Recording of Hoarding as an ASP Harm type on a local basis
- Increased Awareness
- Measurement of data
- Future theme report
